The petitioner has argued that though the Recommendation Committee had recommended six seats, two seats in the trade of Electrician, two in the trade of Fitter and two in the trade of Health Sanitary Inspector, yet respondent No. 2 has passed the impugned order for reducing the said number of seats to half, allowing three in the trade of Electrician, one in the trade of Fitter and one in the trade of Health Sanitary Inspector without giving any reason whatsoever.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the reasons are conspicuously absent in the impugned order and that the impugned order may be set aside and the matter may be remanded back to respondent No. 2 to pass a fresh order in accordance with law, giving reasons for not agreeing with the recommendation.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is hereby allowed.

Annexure P-5 is quashed and the matter is remanded back to respondent No.

2 to decide it a fresh in accordance with law after considering the

recommendation. This exercise shall be concluded within a period of one month from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
