AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the work of labour and carriage was allotted to the petitioner on 30.04.2015 by PUNGRAIN for the rabi season 2015-16. The required documents/securities have been submitted. In pursuance thereto, an agreement has been entered into between the petitioner and Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Limited dated 08.05.2015 (Annexure P-3). Earlier respondents No.5 to 17 were working for the petitioner but thereafter have established their own labour union in the name of Punjab Pradesh Galla Mazdoor Union-respondent No.5. Respondents No.6 to 17 are the members of the said Union. Now the petitioner is facing a situation where the work allotted to it is being disrupted by respondents No. 5 to 17 because of which the petitioner was forced to approach the Station House Officer, Police Station Gharinda (Rural), Amritsar-respondent No.3, by way of representations dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and

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10.07.2015 (Annexure P-7) but till date, no action thereon has been taken.

Counsel, thus, contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Station House Officer, Police Station Gharinda (Rural), Amritsar-respondent No.3 to consider the representations dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Station House Officer, Police Station Gharinda (Rural), Amritsar-respondent No.3 to consider the representations dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, including protection if require, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
