communicated, the counselling was already over at 11.00 A.M on
21.07.2015 and all the 13 seats were filled up and, therefore, the
petitioner could not participate in the admission process.

None of the candidates have been impleaded as
respondent who will have to give way, in case the petitioner is

higher in merit. A period of more than two and half months has expired, since admissions were granted. It is apparent that the petitioner has lost interest in the present writ petition.
