By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the family pensionary benefits after counting work charge service from 01.03.1962 to 01.04.1970 along with interest @ 18 per annum.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved representation dated 09.10.2010 (Annexure P-2), however, the benefits has not been released so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the representation Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
