AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners passed their Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery Course from the Central Board of Secondary Education in the year 2013. On completion of the said course, they had approached the Registrar, Haryana Nurses Registration Council-respondent No.1 but their applications were not accepted on the ground that they had done their course from the Central Board of Secondary Education and not from the nursing college. Counsel for the petitioners contends that this action of the respondents is not sustainable in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.12693 of 2011, titled as 'Saraswati & others Vs. The Registrar, Haryana Nursing Registration Council & others', decided on 30.08.2011 (Annexure P-32). The Letters Patent Appeal No.1905 of 2011 preferred against the said decision of the learned Single Judge, stands dismissed on 08.11.2011 (Annexure P-33). Counsel states that in the light of these

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judgments, petitioners are entitled to their registration with respondent No.1. Petitioners have served a notice through counsel dated 02.05.2015 (Annexure P-34) upon respondent No.1 but till date, no reply to the same has been received nor have they been granted the registration as requested.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Registrar, Haryana Nurses Registration Council-respondent No.1 to consider the legal notice dated 02.05.2015 (Annexure P-34) and decide the same in the light of the judgments referred to above within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Registrar, Haryana Nurses Registration Council-respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 02.05.2015 (Annexure P-34) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

In case, the claim of the petitioners is accepted, the registration certificates be released to them, in accordance with law, within a further period of two weeks.
