By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the entire superannuation benefits and full pension including benefit of commutation of pension in view of Annexure P-1, P-4 and P-5.

The petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing CWP No. 7636 of 2011 which was allowed by this Court, vide order dated 26.04.2012 (Annexure P-4). Against the order dated 26.04.2012 (Annexure P-4), the management preferred LPA which was dismissed, by way of order dated 17.09.2014 (Annexure P-5). The SLP preferred by the management was also dismissed. The learned counsel further contends that subsequent to the finalization of the proceedings, the petitioner had obtained the information under RTI and came to learn that the petitioner is entitled to higher benefits as claimed by him.

There is no mention that the lapse if any on the part of the respondents have been put to their notice by the petitioner. In the circumstances, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same in the light of information obtained by the petitioner through RTI dated 23.10.2009 (Annexure P-8), within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
