By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the revised pay as per the Instruction No. 1/83/2008-2PR(FD) dated 06.01.2010 (Anenxure P-1).

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner retired on 31.08.2010 from the post of Superintendent. After completion of all the formalities by respondent No.2, the case of the petitioner was sent to respondent No.1 for approval which has not been accorded finality. The learned counsel states that he will be satisfied in case the respondent No.1 is directed to consider the case of the petitioner and take a final decision expeditiously.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.1 to finalize the proposal sent by respondent No.2, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
