The present order shall dispose of two writ petitions i.e.  
CWP No. 18041 of 2013 and 15987 of 2014. The facts are being  
taken from 18041 of 2013 as the same institute is involved and the  
dispute is regarding two subsequent academic years.

The petitioner had applied for recognition with the NCTE, which was withdrawn for B.Ed and D.Ed vide order dated 28.01.2013 (Annexure P-7). The appeal of the petitioner was allowed on 25.07.2013 (Annexure P-8) and the matter was remanded to the NRC for necessary action.

The petitioner approached this Court on the ground that since the matter had been remanded, it be allowed to make admission for the academic session 2013-2014, subject to the final outcome of the writ petition. Since, the impugned order had been set aside on remand, the said prayer was allowed. The interim relief was granted on 22.08.2013.

On remand the NRC did not grant recognition vide order dated 19.02.2014 and an appeal was again preferred which again resulted in an remand. On 05.08.2014, the petitioner again approached this Court in CWP No. 15987 of 2014 asking for interim protection to admit students which was granted vide order dated 03.09.2014.

Now, subsequently vide order dated 20.05.2015 recognition has been granted by the NCTE for all basic units of 50 seats with annual intake of 100 seats for academic session 2015-2016, subject to fulfillment of various conditions before 31.08.2015.

The petitioner had also approached in CWP No. 14058 of 2015, since there was dispute regarding for the academic

session 2015-2016. The said writ petition has been allowed on 11.08.2015, keeping in view the specific recognition granted on 20.05.2015. The petitioner-institute has been allowed to make admissions for the session 2015-2016, in view of the recognition granted and on account of the affiliation also.

Resultantly, this Court is of the opinion that once institute stands recognized for subsequent academic years, the initial order of withdrawal of recognition dated 28.01.2013 is no longer invogue on account of the recognition being granted on 20.05.2015 after two remands and the interim direction granted is liable to be confirmed.

Accordingly, the present writ petitions are disposed of by confirming the interim orders dated 22.08.2013 and 03.09.2014 passed in favour of the petitioner-institute.

All the admissions made for the academic sessions 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 shall accordingly stand regularized.
