Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the recoveries from the retiral benefits of the petitioners and for refund of these recovery amounts with interest @18% per annum and for releasing all consequential benefits to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs that the similar relief has been granted in CWP No.4446 of 2010 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the respondents states that same relief will also be released to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, this petition is disposed of with a directions to the respondents to pass the consequential orders within four months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.
