Concededly the petitioners have not filed any objections to the draft notification proposing delimitation of wards. The argument of the petitioners is that representation submitted by the petitioners disputing delimitation of wards has not been decided.

Norms and proper procedure has been prescribed for deciding the process of delimitation, it is the same process which has to be followed and none else. Representation is not a substitute of objections required to be filed to the draft notification.

In view thereof, we do not find any merit in the writ petition. The same is dismissed.
