Written statement of respondent No.5 is taken
on record.

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By filing the instant writ petition, the petitioner
has prayed for quashing the orders dated 26.08.2011 and
01.05.2012 (Annexure P-1 and P-2 respectively), whereby
respondents No.6 and 7 have been promoted to the posts of
Leading Fireman and subsequently to the posts of Sub Fire
Officer at Municipal Council Ferozepur Jhirka and Nuh Fire
Station.

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In the written statement filed on behalf of respondent No.3, it has been stated that show cause notices were issued to respondents No.6 and 7 on 19.10.2013 stating therein that their promotions were against the rules. Further, it is stated that because of the pendency of the instant writ petition, no action on the show cause notices has been taken so far.

In view of the aforesaid fact, learned counsel for the parties agree that the instant writ petition can be disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to take appropriate decision pursuant to the show cause notices issued to respondent No.6 and 7.

In view of above, respondent Nos. 6 and 7 may supplement the reply to the show-cause notices already filed by them.

It is expected that the decision by respondent No.3 would be taken expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
