Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to take legal action against respondent no.4 on the complaint dated 09.07.2014 (Annexure P/7) filed by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in spite of directions issued by the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Department of Development and Panchayats vide order dated 18.02.2015 (Annexure P/9), no order has been passed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the

case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra to dispose of the proceedings pending before him in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
