1. The relief claimed in the present writ petition is to act upon the representation dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P5), made to respondent No.4 for sending a panel of experts to conduct the interview for selection of Principal and teachers for the Diploma of Elementary Education, in view of the letter of intent issued by the National Council for Teacher Education.

2. It is not disputed that the letter of intent was issued on 14.05.2015 and as per Clause 8, necessary compliance had to be done within 2 months of the issue.

Clause 8 reads as under:

“8. The compliance report/reply alongwith all necessary documents accompanied with an Affidavit in support of the reply on the above points should be submitted within two months of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as deemed fit and proper.”

3. The petitioner chose not to agitate for its right and thus, the period expired on 15.07.2015 and thereafter, this Court was approached on 24.07.2015. Though reference has been made to the pendency of CWP No.12034 of 2015 titled *Mastermind Education Society Vs. Union of India & others*, but the facts are different in as much as the petitioner in that case got interim order on 03.06.2015 wherein the letter of intent was ordered to be kept alive.

4. In the present case, the letter of intent is dated 14.05.2015 and in such circumstances, keeping in view the principle that the law is for the vigilant and not for those who sleep over their rights, no relief can be granted to the petitioner for the academic session 2015-16.

4. Writ petitions, accordingly, stand dismissed.
