AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been prematurely discharged from the hospital by the doctor concerned and therefore, he had moved a representation to the Chief Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Ludhiana, requesting therein for constitution of the Medical Board and for readmitting him. The said representation is dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) which has not been, till date, acted upon or decided.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Chief Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) and pass appropriate orders within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of, without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, with direction to the Chief

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Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if so required within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the representation of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well-reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Special Secretary of this Court.
