Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to release the payment of the petitioner for work order form, Book No. 0018 Sr. No. 009, dated 22.02.2014 for which the final bills have already been prepared by respondent no.2 on 17.04.2015 amounting to Rs. 4,52,196/-.

Instant writ petition is not maintainable for this purpose. Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer that direction may be issued to the respondents to decide legal notice dated 20.04.2015 (Annexure P/2) sent by the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to the respondents, to take a decision on the legal notice dated 20.04.2015 (Annexure P/2) sent by the petitioner, in accordance with law and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioner.
