Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider the services rendered by the petitioner in a Government Aided Private College, from 02.08.1976 to 31.08.1978, towards qualifying service for the purposes of pension/pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that similar relief has been granted to the petitioner in ***Ram Diya and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, CWP No.21103 of 2011, decided on 20.11.2014. He states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of in the same terms.

Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that he has no objection, in case, the prayer made is accepted.
