JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

By way of the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the balance payment of Contributory Provident Fund by calculating the same @ 10% of the total salary, as defined in Para 12.3 of the Panjab University Calendar, Chapter-VIII (E) Vol.-I), along with statutory interest.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have served a legal notice, Annexure P-4, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Having regard to the nature of the order being passed, there appears to be no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their counter replies/affidavits, at this stage.

In the circumstances, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the

competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-4, in the light of the decision of this Court rendered in CWP No.8774 of 2004, decided on 06.07.2010 (Annexure P-1), by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
