For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed subject to
all just exceptions. Documents are taken on record.

C.W.P. No.1506 of 2015

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the selection of
respondent No.4 on the post of Teaching Associate in the department of
Biomedical Engineering on the ground that he could not have been
appointed as he was not from the relevant discipline.

It is now stated that during the pendency of this writ petition

one of the posts has fallen vacant and the petitioner would not press this petition on merits. However, a direction is given to the respondents No.1 to 3 to consider her claim against the post which has fallen vacant in the said department.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the above mentioned facts are correct and the respondents want to fill up the post which has been rendered vacant the case of the petitioner be considered. Let the petitioner appear before the respondent No.1 with the necessary application and the respondent No.1 will take a decision thereon within a period of one week thereafter.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
