The petitioner challenges assessment proceedings, assessment order, penalty proceedings, demand notice and attachment of his bank account without appending any document whether in the shape of assessment order, demand notice or any other relevant document that may enable us to consider the petitioner's grievance that assessment and penalty proceedings were finalised without due service or raising a demand notice.

Consequently, we are unable to entertain the present petition but grant liberty to the petitioner to approach the department for supply of relevant orders/documents by filing an appropriate application. In case, such an application is filed within 15 days, all requisite orders/documents shall be supplied to the petitioner within a week thereafter. After receipt of all relevant orders/documents, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
