ARUN PALLI, J.(oral)

A writ in the nature of certiorari is prayed for, so as to quash the order dated 10.07.2015(Annexure P-2), vide which the petitioner has been ordered to be transferred from Hoshiarpur-1 to Bhunga. It is averred that the petitioner is slated to retire after four months i.e. on 30.11.2015 on attaining the age of 60 years. And, thus, her transfer is in apparent breach of Transfer Policy(Annexure P-1). She purports to be a widow.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition so as to enable the petitioner to approach the respondents, in the first instance, as regards her grievance. He submits that a comprehensive representation in this regard shall be made within a week from today

to respondent Nos.2 and 3. And, thus, they be directed to consider and decide the same within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, if indeed any such representation is made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided, strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the receipt of such representation. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed, assigning reasons in support of the decision arrived at.
