Through this application, Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib is sought to be impleaded as respondent No.7 in the main writ petition.

In view of the averments made in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.7 in the main writ petition. Amended memo of parties filed alongwith the application is ordered to be taken on record.

Civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.7 to take a decision on the representation dated 24.06.2015 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioners. I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners to be reasonable.

the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
