Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the letter of intent dated 31.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.3 whereby Regular Retail Outlet/Fuel Station has been awarded to respondent No.5 for the location on village Katani-Kalan on Kharar-Ludhiana Road, Section of NH-95, in Tehsil and District Ludhiana.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned authorities to look into the grievance of the petitioner as mentioned in

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legal notice dated 16.06.2015 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same, in accordance with law, expeditiously preferably within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
