Prayer in this petition is for issuing a writ of mandamus, directing respondent authorities to lay road after proper alignment and demarcation of the site.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the land on which the road is being built/constructed is an acquired land. He appears to be aggrieved with the alignment of the road. This grievance of the petitioner cannot be gone into in a writ petition as National Highway Authorities of India is an expert body and is the best judge to see the alignment of the road. The Court is not inclined to interfere in the present writ petition. Since no land of the petitioner has been encroached upon by the respondents, he has no grievance, which the Court, at this stage, can redress.

Finding no merit in the writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
