This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to decide the complaint (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.

The main grievance of the petitioner is that the complaints (Annexures P-1& P-2) moved by him have not been decided so far by respondent No.2. He further submits that, at this stage, he will be satisfied, in case, the respondents are directed to decide his complaints(Annexures P-1 & P-2).

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the complaints(Annexures P-1 & P-2) moved by the petitioner,

expeditiously, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The decision taken thereon by respondent No.2 be communicated to the complainant.
