ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw this petition, so as to enable the petitioner to pursue his cause before the Financial Commissioner (Taxation), Punjab, in the first instance. Particularly, when an appeal preferred by the petitioner under Rule 7 of the Punjab Excise and Taxation Inspector (Group 'C') Service Rules, 2008, (Annexure P10), against the order of his termination dated 23.01.2015 (Annexure P9), is pending consideration. Accordingly, he submits that Financial Commissioner (Taxation), Punjab, be directed to consider and decide the said appeal, within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, if indeed, the petitioner has appealed against the order of his termination dated 23.01.2015 (Annexure P9), the Financial Commissioner (Taxation), Punjab, would consider and decide the same, strictly in accordance with law, and pass an appropriate order within 4 weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. It is made clear that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the claim of the petitioner.
