This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to reconstruct the Service Book and to release all retiral benefits to the petitioner.

Learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a demand notice(Annexure P-5), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to decide the demand notice(Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
