This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the remaining retiral dues i.e. Provident Fund, installments of Dearness Allowance and 50% arrears of new pay scales to the petitioner from 01.01.2006 with interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has moved a representation(Annexure P-2), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to decide the representation(Annexure P-2), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
