The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits including pensionary benefits, commuted pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund under the revised pay scales and arrears on account of revision of pay and other benefits as he retired on 31.03.2015 on attaining the age of superannuation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the pensionary benefits have not been released to the petitioner in spite of serving legal notice upon the respondents. He further submits that the case of present petitioner is squarely covered by decision in **CWP No.6488 of 2012** titled as **Raj Kumar vs State of Punjab and others** decided on **04.04.2012**. Learned counsel also submits that neither any action has been taken on the legal notice nor the retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to

respondent No.4 to consider the legal notice.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider the claim of the petitioner regarding releasing the retiral benefits as have been mentioned in the legal notice and take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, the necessary benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled, be released to him.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
