Instant petition has been filed for quashing Annexure P-18 dated 2.12.2014 passed by respondent No.1 wherein the inquiry was conducted and the authorities have come to a conclusion that the charge does not stand proved against the delinquent.

Since the allegations of the petitioner are with regard to the misconduct by way of drawing a false bill, this Court is not the right forum in these proceedings under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Such like disputed facts can only be gone into by the competent authority. No ground for interference is made out. Even the petition in the present form is not maintainable and appears to be frivolous.

Dismissed.
