The grievance of the petitioners is that there cannot be 85 voters in one house bearing No.157 in the village Sarai Aurangabad, Tehsil Bahadurgarh.

It is a question of fact whether such numbers of persons are residents of a particular address. The petitioners can seek exclusion of the names of the alleged residents as not to be residents of the said house which can be factually verified by the Competent Authorities.

In view thereof, we do not find any reason to interfere in the extra-ordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court in respect of correction of the electoral rolls.

However, it shall be open to the petitioners to seek the remedies as may be available to the petitioners under law.
