Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is, inter alia, for issuance of a direction to the respondents to supply the order whereby the passport of the petitioner has been cancelled/impounded.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naresh Goel, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 14.4.2015 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-8) dated 14.4.2015.

Considering the prayer made, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the authorities to consider and decide the representation dated 14.4.2015 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within six weeks from the

date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 is directed to communicate the decision to the concerned authorities for compliance.

Disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
