1. This order shall dispose of two writ petitions bearing CWPs No. 15369 and 15372 of 2015 as according to learned counsel for the parties, the issues involved in these writ petitions are identical. The facts are being taken from CWP No. 15369 of 2015.
2. The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent No. 3 to refund the amount due as per the returns.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the writ petition, refund amount has been released to the petitioner(s) and therefore, the present writ petitions have been rendered infructuous. However, he further claims interest on the refunded amount.
4. Disposed of as infructuous.
5. However, it shall be open to the petitioner(s) to make representation

if so advised for claiming interest before the appropriate authority. If such a representation is filed by the petitioner(s), the same shall be dealt with by the concerned authority in accordance with law.
