The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 15.11.2011 (Annexure P-6), whereby grant of license for running Fair Price Shop at Village Laddi, District Sangrur has been issued to respondent No. 5.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Vide impugned letter dated 15.11.2011 issued by Deputy Director (Field), Food & Supplies Department, Patiala

Division, Patiala to District Controller, Food & Supplies & Consumer matters Sangrur, approval for allotment of Ration Depot to respondent No. 5 has been accorded. It has been specifically mentioned in the letter that at the time of issuance of license of this depot compliance of Government instructions be made literally and it may be assured that the applicant receiving the license is complying with the instructions/conditions issued from time to time. Instructions of the Government regarding reservation be complied strictly.

Since, virtually no order has been passed and only approval has been granted subject to compliance of relevant instructions/conditions, the grievance of the petitioner is premature, as no violation of the instructions/conditions has been shown. Hence, the present petition is even not maintainable.

Dismissed.
