The petitioner has challenged the order dated 05.12.2014 (P-4) passed by the Divisional Canal Officer, Rohtak whereby the Water Course from point 'AB' on the Killa Line has been sanctioned on payment of compensation through the field No.22/3/1, 3/2, 8/2 (0-5 marlas) passing through the field of the petitioner for better irrigation of the field of the applicant/respondent Balkishan. Further challenge is to the order dated 06.04.2015 (P-6) and orders dated 3.6.2015 (P-7) passed by the Superintending Canal Officer and Chief Canal Officer respectively upholding the order dated 05.12.2014 (P-4) while dismissing the appeals of the petitioner-appellant.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner and very carefully perusing the impugned orders and the site plan, this Court finds no fault with the impugned orders. In the interest of better irrigation, a Water

Course has been provided to the applicant/respondent after framing a scheme and following the due procedure under Section 30-FF of The Northern India Canal & Drainage Act, 1873. The concurrent finding of facts do not warrant any interference.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
