The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles

226/227 of the Constitution of India directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to initiate proceedings against respondents No. 4 to 6 under Section 20(1) (d) to (f) of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 as the respondents No. 4 to 6 have failed to attend the meetings of the Gram Panchayat.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, reply on behalf of the State by way of an affidavit of Sh. Surinder Pal Angra, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar has been filed. It has been mentioned in Annexure R-3 annexed with the reply that complaint was enquired into. Now all the Panches have participated in the meeting.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has become infructuous.

If the respondents fail to appear in the meetings, the petitioner will be at liberty to inform the concerned Department, which shall take action in accordance with law immediately.
