The petitioner's claim to additional pay and allowances for officiating as DDO is, according to the counsel, squarely governed through the instructions of the government issued through the Director Public Instructions dated 23.4.2012. The petitioner has also issued a notice Annexure P/11 to respondent No.2. The 2nd respondent shall consider the representation in the light of the instructions issued by the Government under Annexure P/9 dated 23.4.2012 and a decision taken within a period of two weeks. If the decision admits the petitioner's claim, the amount due shall be reckoned and released to the petitioner within eight weeks. The notice is dispensed with, since the matter is reported to be squarely covered.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
