AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner-Hospital was empanelled with the respondents under the Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojna guidelines in the year 2009 for BPL card holders. The petitioner-Hospital continued to provide the services. A show cause notice dated 31.07.2013 (Annexure P-1) was issued to the petitioner pointing out the deficiencies and finally, a Committee was constituted which reported in favour of the petitioner. The petitioner, however, was repanelled after the de-panellment. Petitioner thereafter had been approaching the respondents for payment of the outstanding dues under the Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojna Scheme but without any response. One of the said representation is dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10) which also has not yielded any result.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents

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No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Director, ESI Health Card, NAC Mani Majra, Chandigarh-respondent No.2; Addl. Deputy Commissioner-cum-DKMA, RSBY, Kurukshetra-respondent No.3 and United Insurance Company through its Senior Divisional Manager, SAS Nagar, Mohali-respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Consequential benefits, if any, be released to the petitioner within a further period of one month.
