The petitioners who were appointed on contract basis apprehend that their services may be substituted by other directly appointed employees.

Counsel for the respondents has stated that the petitioners have been engaged through a service provider and as of now there is no proposal to replace them by any other similarly situated employees and the respondents would have no objection if the service provider continues to sponsor the petitioners for the job.

Counsel for the petitioners states that in this view of the

statement made by counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may be dismissed at this stage as having been rendered infructuous.
