1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This writ petition has been filed challenging the award dated 23.08.2012(Annexure P-15). After arguing for some time a limited agreement has been arrived at between the learned counsel. It has been agreed that the award would be set aside and respondent No.3 would appoint a fresh arbitrator and both the parties would have the liberty to take all pleas available to them before the arbitrator so appointed. It has further been agreed that respondent No.3 would appoint the arbitrator within two months from the date of receipt of a

certified copy of this order in terms of Section 7-B of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 and the said arbitrator will decide the entire dispute as expeditiously as possible in view of the fact that the matter has been delayed already.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
