Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that petitioner is a sikh minority institution, who applied for recognition from the NCTE. The said recognition has been granted on 2.3.2015 and the matter has been referred to the Government of Haryana. Respondent No.3 has referred the matter to respondent No.2 to take an appropriate decision but so far neither the request made by the petitioner has been accepted or rejected.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner only submits that an appropriate direction may be issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on its application either way as the matter is of an urgency for the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid submissions and prayer made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the prayer of the petitioner, which is still pending with it, having been sent by respondent No.3, within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
