The petitioner has joined at Ropar in pursuance of the offer earlier made by the State on 14.10.2015.

The challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 22.06.2015 (Annexure P-6), whereby the petitioner has transferred from Civil Hospital, Mohali to District Hospital, Mansa.

In such circumstances, once in view of the offer given on an earlier date on 14.10.2015, she has joined at Ropar, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous qua that prayer.

The prayer for salary for the period she remained terminated is without any basis. It is a matter of fact that petitioner

was appointed on contract as a Homeopathic Medical Officer vide letter dated 02.01.2009. Vide letter dated 30.05.2014 her services were terminated on account of Clause 2 to 5 of her appointment letter, wherein her service could be terminated on account of the mis-behaviour and deficiency in work and conduct. She has only been reinstated on 22.06.2015 on account of her representation having been made to the Health Minister, who has sympathetically cancelled the termination order.

In such circumstances, once the petitioner has not worked for the abovesaid period, the question of any payment of emoluments would not arise.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of.
