Learned State counsel, on instructions from Shri Ramanpreet Singh, Clerk, office of Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Punjab, Patiala, submits that pursuant to an order passed by this Court on 01.03.2013 in CWP-14815-2011, the vacancy position as regards the posts of Excise and Taxation Inspectors in different categories was revised and, as a result, the petitioner was offered appointment, but despite repeated intimations to the petitioner, he did not opt to participate in the counselling. However, one post of Excise and Taxation Inspector in the Ex-serviceman Backward Class category has since been kept reserved, petitioner, if still willing, can report for scrutiny of the necessary documents before Excise and Taxation

Commissioner, Punjab, Patiala, on or after 29.07.2015.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in the petition and the same be disposed of as having become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
