The learned counsel refers to Annexure P-4 and P-5 to contend that the ex-post facto sanction was accorded by the competent authority for reimbursement of the medical bills pertaining to the treatment of husband of the petitioner. Despite the specific order, Annexure P-4 and P-5, the necessary funds have not been released in favour of the petitioner. The learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to decide the representations dated 20.03.2014/13.08.2014 (Annexure P-3 colly.).

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.3 to examine the case of the petitioner within eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and if the answer is in affirmative, then the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.
