The challenge in the present writ petition is to an interim order passed by Debts Recovery Tribunal-I, Chandigarh (for short 'Tribunal') on 23.06.2015 wherein an interlocutory application filed by the applicants to determine whether the land in question is agricultural land or not was declined. Learned Tribunal has recorded that the applicants are filing interlocutory application one after another whereas the case is already mature for final arguments. It has been also found that the petitioner has been granted No Objection Certificate for school on the whole land, therefore, it cannot be said that the land is agricultural land.

The order passed by the Tribunal is an appealable order. In view thereof, we do not find that any case is made out for interference in exercise of writ jurisdiction of this Court in view of the findings recorded by the Tribunal.

Dismissed.
