The prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents be directed to release the retiral benefits and monthly pension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that for claiming the relief, the petitioner got a legal notice dated 6.12.2014 (Annexure P-1) issued to the respondents, however, the same has not been responded to. It is further submitted that for the aforesaid claim at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 6.12.2014 (Annexure P-1) got served by her within certain specified time.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, in my opinion, the present petition can be disposed of at this stage without issuing notice to the respondents with a direction to respondent No. 2 to take final decision on the legal notice dated 6.12.2014 (Annexure P-1) got served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any amount is found to be due to the petitioner, the same shall be paid to her within 15

days thereafter. In case of failure, the petitioner shall be entitled to interest @ 18% from the date of retirement, which will be recovered from the guilty officer/official.

Ordered accordingly.
