Haryana Staff Selection Commission through advertisement dated 8.7.2013 invited applications for 364 posts of Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant (VLDA). The petitioners applied for consideration of their candidature for appointment to the advertised posts but considering them to be ineligible, they were not issued interview letters. Challenging such inaction on the part of the respondents, the present writ petition has been filed.

Today, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. D.A.G. Haryana, learned State counsel has stated that the above-said advertisement has been withdrawn by the Government which renders the present writ petition infructuous.

In view of the above statement made by the learned State counsel, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
