It is contended that complete case for reimbursement of the medical expenses incurred by the petitioner on the treatment of her husband who died in the year 2013, were submitted in the month of April, 2013. Despite the repeated representations, no action has so far been taken by the competent authority.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to examine and decide the case of the petitioner, within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, on examination the authority comes to the conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief sought, the consequential benefits shall be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.
