AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that two different works, details of which is mentioned in para 2 of the writ petition, were allotted to the petitioner. The said works were completed and an amount of ₹41,35,013/- is due towards the petitioner from the respondents. Petitioner had been approaching the respondents for release of the said amount but without any response. Faces with this situation, a notice through counsel dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) upon the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation, Ferozepur-respondent No.5, but that also has not solicited any response.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation, Ferozepur-respondent No.5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) within some specified time.

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In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation, Ferozepur-respondent No.5 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of one month. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
