AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court highlighting his grievance in the form that FIR No.157 dated 22.06.2015, has been registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, on the statement of the petitioner. The injuries which have been received by the petitioner are two in number out of which Injury No.1 is declared to be grievous. The son of the petitioner, Jagjit Singh has received four injuries out of which, Injury No.2 has been declared as grievous while, the other injuries are simple in nature. He contends that the petitioner having received grievous injuries, Section 326 of IPC needs to be added in the FIR, but no action is being taken by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner has submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) but no action thereon has been taken.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if required, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
