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**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):**

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that in the light of the order passed by the National Green Tribunal, the petitioner intends to shift its diesel vehicles and accordingly, the petitioner had moved to the Registering Authority, Faridabad, under the Motor Vehicles Act, vide representation/application dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) for issuance of a fitness certificate, no objection certificate to ply the vehicles (diesel vehicles more than ten years old) beyond the territorial limits of Delhi State and National Capital Region and deposit of Goods Tax and Token Tax. The list of vehicles have been appended alongwith the said application. Another application has been submitted by the petitioner on 23.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) when nothing was heard from the respondents with regard to his earlier request dated 14.07.2015 but

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that has also not solicited any response. Petitioner is suffering because of inaction on the part of the respondents as his business has come to a standstill and the vehicles are not being plied.

Counsel contends that a direction may be issued to the Registering Authority, Regional Transport Office, Faridabad-respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation/application dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Registering Authority, Regional Transport Office, Faridabad-respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation/application dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

A photocopy of this order be given *dasti* to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Special Secretary of this Court.
